SKILLS RECOGNITION

TRAINING & ASSESSMENT MODES :

Delivery of this course is undertaken in a simulated salon environment. Training is delivered mainly in the classroom environment where a combination of practical and theory sessions, class activities and group participation is part of the delivery strategy.

Students are to provide models for class as and when required.

Assessment is undertaken on a continuous basis throughout the enrolment period. Assessment methods may include all or a combination of the following:

- Practical Demonstration
- Written/Theory
- Class presentations
- Oral Questions/explanations/discussions
- Treatment Plans/Case Studies
- Student treatment log books
- Portfolios
- Assignments
- Tasks

Student **treatment plans/case studies** and treatment **log book** are part of the gathering of evidence on a range of clients with different requirements. These assessment methods must be completed before any qualifications can be issued. Students will receive an Assessment Record that will record the achievement of the Unit/s of Competency as they are assessed.
