Correspondence students are expected to complete their studies within a 6 month period.

The Text Book and DVD's will be sent to you along with your assignments. Upon completion of each assignment, please forward them to the College for marking. When the papers are marked they will be returned to you with results and any comments.

You will be contacted periodically regarding your progress and if you need any assistance, contact us by phone or email.

The Theory assessment will be conducted at the College or with either a JP, Principal of a school, police officer, or the like. The theory paper will be sent to whom you nominate and returned to us after completion. Papers will be marked and you will be notified of your results.

The Practical assessment must be conducted at the College. You will need to make arrangements with the Correspondence Co-ordinator for a time suitable to both. You are welcome to attend the College throughout the duration of your course from time to time. This will allow you the opportunity to get assistance to correct your techniques, give you encouragement and confidence in your knowledge and skills. Please notify us if you wish to attend so that we can arrange a class for your participation.

ASSESSMENT:
